Read Galatians 5:13-26 in the NIV

1. We live in a culture where everyone is demanding more and more freedom, freedom to do whatever they want to do.
But when freedom is used to sin, it always leads to addiction. Discuss.

2. Read Galatians 5:13
"Our freedom in Christ is not a license to sin, but an opportunity to serve." Discuss.

3. Read Galatians 5:14
The freedom to love is so amazing and so powerful that it can take the place of every law ever given. Discuss.

4. Read Galatians 5:15
No matter how many religious laws and rules we have, spiritual unity is not something that can be enforced. Discuss.

5. Read Galatians 5:16
The grace and truth of Jesus Christ sets us free, and when we begin to understand who Jesus is, and all that He has done for us, we can't help but ask, "How can I live for Him?"

6. Read Galatians 5:17
Our sin nature, the desires of the flesh, are at war with the Spirit.
That's why as a Christian, we are not to do whatever we want. Discuss.

7. Read Galatians 5:18
The answer is not the law. All of the laws, rules and regulations in the world cannot defeat the desires of your sinful nature. The answer is not our will power. The answer is to be led by the Spirit. Discuss.

8. Read Galatians 5:19-21
God does not make the distinction between the sins like we do.
God puts jealousy and self ambition right there with the worst of the sexual sins. Discuss.

9. Read Galatians 5:22-23
The growth of spiritual fruit is gradual, natural and balanced. Discuss.
Our spiritual fruit is not for us to put on display but to serve others and glorify God.
Discuss.
