Read Galatians 6:1-10 in the NIV
Pray

1. In addition to caring for each other, one of the most important parts of the Christian life is to grow in "holiness". Discuss.

2. There is always the temptation to take a shortcut and just deal with what is seen on the outside and do religious things that make us appear to be holy. But true holiness always begins in the heart and then changes us from the inside out. Discuss.

3. Read Galatians 6:1
What does it mean to be "overtaken in wrongdoing?"
How do you "restore a person with a gentle spirit?"

4. Read Galatians 6:2
What does it mean to "carry one another's burdens?"

5. Read Galatians 6:3
How are church people guilty many times of deceiving themselves?

6. Read Galatians 6:4
We are not to compare ourselves with each other. We are to look at the gifts, abilities and talents that God has blessed us with. We should measure ourselves against ourselves and how God is using us to be a blessing to others and then it's OK to feel good about what God is doing in our life, as long as we give Him the glory. Discuss.

7. Read Galatians 6:5
This seems to contradict the command in verse 2. Discuss.

8. Read Galatians 6:7
"Whatever a person plants he will also harvest." Discuss.

9. Read Galatians 6:9
One of the problems that keeps us from doing the right thing is there is usually not an immediate reward and we all like instant results. Discuss.

10. Read Galatians 6:10
We all have a limited amount of time to bless others and to glorify God. We should not take that time for granted. Discuss.
