Read Galatians 5:1-12 in the NIV

Pray

1. The Christian who lives in the freedom of God's grace will not live their life however they choose to live, but because they have surrendered their heart to God, they choose to obey Him and the teachings of the Bible.

Discuss.

2. It's the natural tendency in all of us to make it all about us.

That's why as a church we have to constantly fight against the pull to be inwardly focused.

To fight against believing that I come to church just to get my needs met.

Discuss.

3. Anytime we live outside of God's grace and truth we live outside of God's very best for us.

Discuss.

4. Read Galatians 5:1 (NIV)

The guide for how a Christian should live their life is scripture.

Not what you think is right. Not what you feel is right.

Only scripture, the Word of God.

Culture does not determine what is right and wrong.

Discuss.

5. May humility always be our filter on social media.

Stand firm with grace and truth covered in love and humility.

Discuss.

6. Read Galatians 5:2

Paul uses the religious act of circumcision as an example, but it's not specifically the act of circumcision that's the problem. It's anything that we do, that we think makes us right with God. Discuss.

7. Read Galatians 5:4

This does not mean that someone who was a Christian is no longer a Christian.

Since there is nothing we can do to earn our salvation,  
there is nothing we can do to lose our salvation.

But what about the person who once followed Jesus and is now no longer following Jesus?

Discuss.

8. Read Galatians 5:6

The religious stuff that we do in our own power is absolutely worthless.

But when we serve others and bring glory to God in faith through love,

it's the only thing that really matters. Discuss. Pray
