Read Jeremiah 1:1-19

1. Think about one of the worst jobs possible.
What are some of the excuses you would use to try to get out of it?
2. What were some of the differences between an Old Testament priest and an Old Testament prophet?
3. One of the ways that God gets our attention when we drift away from Him is to bring people like Jeremiah into our lives to warn us.
Why do think that many times we do not listen to what they have to say?
4. We came up with 4 possible reasons that Jeremiah may have hesitated in following God.
Do you remember the first reason?
How could having your own plans keep you from doing God's will?
5. Obedience is not always the easiest way. Do you agree? Why or why not?
6. Jeremiah lacked confidence that he could do what God was asking him to do.
Read 2 Corinthians 2:16 and 2 Corinthians 3:5

Read Jeremiah 1:5-8 and 1 Corinthians 15:10

His life was in danger because of his unpopular message.
He was be misunderstood, persecuted and arrested.
